Year Group: 12

Term One

Students will have two teachers for this course and cover:

Feedback on the summer task.

The genre of tragedy.

They will study 'The Great Gatsby', 'Death of a Salesman', 'Othello' and 'Keats', 'L'Amia', 'Isabella', 'La Belle Dame sans merci' and 'The Eve of St Agnes'.

Term Two

Revision of the four tests in this unit on tragedy with a focus on assessment objectives, planning and exam technique.

Practice exams take place in January.

Term Three

Students will focus on exam techniques and completing practice papers prior to the paper 1 & 2 exams on the genre of tragedy.

Introduction to the non-examination assessment, critical anthology and independent reading.

Term One

Students will have two teachers for this A2 course and cover:

Study of the 'Go-Between for unit 4 coursework _further and independent study-comparison) students will independently read a second text and essay titles will be checked with our coursework advisor.

Introduction to the unit 4 critical anthology.

Completion of studying texts for unit 3 element of the Gothic ('Macbeth', 'The Pardoner's Tale' 'The Bloody Chamber').

Term Two

Practice exams take place in January- Unit 3 (Elements of the Gothic)

Both coursework titles will be agreed and a priority will be the independent planning and drafting of coursework. All final drafts of coursework will be submitted by Easter.

Additionally, there will be revision of the four Gothic texts ('Macbeth', 'The Pardoner's Tale' 'The Bloody Chamber and 'Frankenstein').

Term Three

Coursework is standardised and submitted to the moderator by 15.5.16
