Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back to all students following the half term break. We are all ready for a busy half term that will include a number of evening events, the first of which is the school production which opens in less than two weeks. Over 50 students are involved in the production of The Little Shop of Horrors, which runs from Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> to Friday 16<sup>th</sup> November. I would like to praise the students involved in the production for the time and effort they have put in to the show. They will have taken part in 150 hours of rehearsals in school and I'm sure countless more hours have gone in to practising at home. I hope that you will support our students by purchasing tickets and joining us in school for one, or more, of the evenings. Tickets are available now from the Performing Arts office (Adults: £6 and Concessions £3).

Over the last few weeks we have received voluntary contributions from parents and carers totalling £1,665. I would like to thank everyone who has made a contribution. These funds will help the school provide Technology and Art materials in Key Stage 3 and 'GCSE pods' (an online revision resource lasting the duration of a GCSE course). If you haven't yet made a voluntary contribution and would like to do so please contact the school's finance team. Contributions range from £5-£15 depending on the year group your child is in.

Today we had the final site meeting regarding the refurbishment of the 'old science block' which is really beginning to take shape and looks very smart. The project is running to schedule and the building should be handed over to us towards the end of the month. I'm sure staff and students will be pleased to see the new facility – though we will not start using it till the Spring term in January.

Next week Year groups will have assemblies focusing on Remembrance and the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the end of World War 1 in the build up to the centenary on Armistice Day on November 11<sup>th</sup>.

We received four nominations for the two Parent Governor vacancies, which means we have to proceed to an election. Ballot papers and return envelopes are being distributed home this week via the youngest student in each family. There are two ballot papers per household and each parent has a single vote for each vacancy, therefore two votes. Completed forms and envelopes must be returned to reception by 12 noon on 12 November 2018.
