As your son/daughter/ward approaches the end of their high school studies, we at Blackpool Sixth are extremely keen to support them in whatever way we can with the next exciting stage of their education and career.

Students who have already applied to Blackpool Sixth will have received a lot of information and support from our admissions team to prepare them for starting their studies with us.

It is not too late to apply for entry in September 2024. We strongly recommend that students apply to us before January via our website: www.blackpoolsixth.ac.uk/apply

The application does not mean that a student is committed to joining Blackpool Sixth. It is simply an initial show of interest and gives them access to a range of events designed to support them in their decision making about their future. They can apply to more than one college or training provider.

We know that students might not be totally sure about their choice of courses when they apply, so they will have access to expert advice and guidance to help them with their choices. They can make changes, if they need to, after they have submitted the application form.

The application gives students **exclusive access** to the following events when they can try out courses in specialised taster sessions.

**Taster Day -** Saturday 16th March 2024 10.30 - 1.00 **Taster Evening -** 27th March 2024 5.30 - 8.00 **New Student Day -** 4th July 2024 9.30 - 2.30

No final decisions about joining Blackpool Sixth or about course choices are made until the GCSE results are published in August 2024. At that point we have a process of enrolment during which a student confirms their decisions.
