

What is the Pupil Premium?

The Pupil Premium is the name of the fund given directly to schools to support students who are in receipt of Free School Meals , or who have been registered within the last 6 years. The children of Armed Forces families and young people who are in care are also eligible for Pupil Premium funding.

These funds are in addition to the main school budget and are allocated on the basis of the number of students who qualify for the Pupil Premium.

To register for Free School Meals and The Pupil Premium apply online at www.lancashire.gov.uk or telephone Lancashire County Council on **(01524) 581 207**

You will need to provide your name, National Insurance number and your child's date of birth.

You will be told immediately if you are eligible and the next steps in the process.

Unfortunately, we are not allowed to telephone on behalf of the parent or carer; it has to be done by the individual concerned.

The Pupil Premium Promise

Carr Hill High School is investing its Pupil Premium to ensure the maximum impact on the academic achievement and non-academic performance of those students who qualify for this. Our promise for every qualifying student is:

- Access to our **Pupil Premium Mentor** to help with all aspects of school, with regular meetings in school.
- Guaranteed access to our **Homework Club** in the Hub, supervised by school staff to offer expert guidance and help.
- Access to our free **Late Bus***, so that our Pupil Premium students can attend extra curricular activities and homework club.
- A Residential Trip to a **Lancashire Outdoor Education Centre**; including motivational workshops and adventurous activities.
- Intensive **tracking and monitoring** of each student's progress.
- Access to a **Careers Advisor** (through referral by Mrs Somers) to receive career advice and **university visits** to raise aspirations.
- **Parental meetings** in school with Mrs Somers and/or a member of the Senior Leadership team.
- **Attendance** is regularly monitored, and **Intervention** to improve the attendance of identified students.
- **Financial Contribution** towards the registration fee of the Duke of Edinburgh Scheme.

* students must sign up daily to use the Late Bus. (Only available within the local area, on a dedicated route and strictly on a first come first served basis).

In addition to the 'Pupil Premium Promise', those students currently qualifying for Free School Meals will also be eligible for:

- **Guaranteed access to our free Breakfast Club, coordinated by Mrs Somers (Pupil Premium Mentor) in the dining room. The Breakfast Club is available to invited students only.**
- **Revision guides and revision material where appropriate, for KS4 students.**
- **Stationery supplies, where appropriate, for KS3 and KS4.**
- **Enhanced curriculum intervention for identified students.**
- **Opportunities to enthuse, engage and raise aspirations.**
- **An invitation to our Summer School, for all Year 6 Pupil Premium students transitioning to Carr Hill in September.**
- **Help with funding for school trips, where appropriate.**
- **Access to academic mentoring in Year 11, for underperforming students.**
- **Invite to our free KS3 Family Cookery Club.**
- **Funding towards instrumental lessons.**
